CLIMBING PEAS

Here's our handy guide for growing your child's pea seeds, sown in this week's Kindergarden workshop.

What you will need:

- Water
- A sunny indoor and outdoor location
- Self-watering pot
- A pea plant climbing frame

Remove seed pot lid and place your Studio Cultivate Seed Pot in a warm and sunny space. Check daily to ensure that soil is moist.

The first roots, stem and leaves should emerge from the soil within 14-21 days.

Once seedling is approximately 7cm tall, gently remove from seed pot by turning pot upside down and squeezing. Keep root ball intact.

Transplant seedling to a larger, self-watering pot (**see video above**) and watch as seedling grows into an almost-grown-up plant, ready to be planted in a sunny garden spot (3-4 weeks).

Peas are climbing plants, so once outdoors, plants will require a support structure/frame. Watch 'Your Climbing Pea Plant' for tips at studiocultivate.com/onlineresources
