Armed with a field guide complete with garden map and dinosaur profiles, you will hunt down and document the living fossils that were munched by these magnificent reptiles. You'll need to call on a number of skills to win over your peers at the APB conference as you use art, drama, maths and science to see these ancient plants in a whole new light. The day finishes with the group creating their very own Mesozoic garden-terrarium to take home and treasure for eons!

PlayGreen is an exciting hybrid of outdoor theatre and garden exploration that uses plants, animals and the natural world as a means to explore stories old and new. A vibrant mash-up of performance, play and participation!

A typical Play Green event can include botany, history, literature, science, maths, art, physical education and drama. Something for everyone! As well as a day packed full of adventure, each participant will leave with a take-home element as a memento of the day.
